Currently a member of Hyde Park Christian Church where she serves as an Elder, Rev. Julie Wood was Executive Director of the Texas Bible Chair Foundation for eight years and served as Associate and Acting Senior Minister at Round Rock Christian Church. Prior to her work with the Texas

Bible Chair Foundation, Julie trained and worked as a chaplain at Seton Medical Center in Austin. She is an active member of the Central Texas Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) team, which provides counseling and debriefing to first responders – police, fire and EMS – following disasters and other critical incidents. Julie moved to Austin almost 20 years ago from Washington, DC, where she had been a political event planner and fundraiser for many years. While in DC, she received her master's degree from Wesley Theological Seminary, so she's a Disciple trained by the

Methodists! She was ordained into vocational ministry by University Christian Church in Austin in April 2006. A native of Evansville, Indiana, Julie graduated with a journalism degree from Northwestern University near Chicago. As perhaps the World's Oldest First-time Bride, Julie married Mike Carpenter on New Year's Day 2020. They live in Austin with their three neurotic cats.

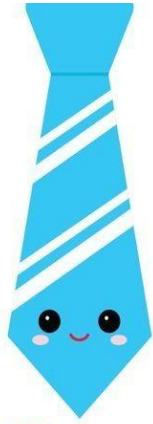
**May Outreach Project a Huge Success**
